



Traineeship Contribution Charges

Students are required to pay a **Tuition Contribution** as prescribed by the State Government. All fees are payable at the time of enrolment.

Tuition Contribution

- The Tuition Contribution is charged at the rate of \$1.37 for each nominal enrolled hour up to a maximum of 640 hours for a continuous 12 month period
- A **\$57 minimum Tuition Contribution fee applies to all students**, including those who may be eligible for a concession, for a continuous 12 month period
- The **maximum Tuition Contribution fee payable by any student is \$877** for a continuous 12 month period

Example, a typical Certificate III in Fitness traineeship requires enrolment in modules totalling between 506 and 592 nominal hours (depending on electives). Tuition contributions in this case would range from \$693 to \$811.

Concessions

Students (or listed dependants) who hold one of the following concession cards will be eligible for a concession on Tuition Contribution only:

- Commonwealth Health Care Card
- Pensioner Concession Card
- Veterans Gold Card

Concessions will be granted upon presentation of a concession card. E.g. Health Care Card. Cards must be valid at the time of course commencement and payment of fees.
